Musical Elements

Dynamics-volume

Rhythm-a pattern of long and short notes

Pitch-how high or low a note/instrument is

Articulation-smooth or detached notes

Tempo-speed of the music

Texture-how many layers there are


Structure-how the sections of music are put together

Melody-the main tune

Instrumentation—the instruments and voice used

Tonality-major (happy) or minor (sad)

Harmony-the notes which make up the backing (not the melody)






